the graduate program "Markets and Social Systems in Europe" (GP MSE) would like to encourage outstanding students of sociology, political sciences, social politics, economics, finance, and of international management to apply for one of four PhD- Scholarships granted by the German Research Foundation in corporation with the University of Bamberg. Scholarships are currently 1103 € per month and will be initially awarded for two years with the option to receive a third year of funding. Funding will either start in spring or autumn 2009. Classes are taught in German, papers and thesis may be written in English. Students are expected to choose Bamberg as their place of residence.

We would also like to encourage outstanding researchers in the fields mentioned above holding a PhD to apply for one of two Postdoctoral Fellowships. Fellowships are granted as full positions TV-L13 (public sector salary) and are awarded for the duration of two years.

The graduate program focuses on the interdisciplinary analysis of changes and developments in markets and social systems in the context of global competition, European regulation and national traditions. Students are asked to apply with a research project from any of the disciplinary backgrounds stated above.
