Each submitted paper should indicate the email and affiliation of the corresponding author and an abstract. Please underline the name of the presenting author. By submitting a paper, the authors agree that the paper may be made available on the conference website.

A decision on the acceptance of papers will be made by the committee. Authors will be notified by April 30, 2010. Accepted speakers will be asked to send the final version of the paper and register after notification by May 31, 2010. Travel and accommodation costs for speakers and presenters of accepted papers will be reimbursed.
