Short description of vacancy: The start date will be 1 October 2018. The funding of the doctorate is available for a period of four years. The successful applicant is expected to contribute to a research project on migration, education and labor-markets and complete a doctoral dissertation under the supervision of Prof. Martina Viarengo. The initial appointment would be for 12 months beginning 1 October 2018, and can be extended on satisfactory performance.

Requirements: You have completed a Master degree in one of the social sciences (preferably economics). Excellent knowledge of quantitative research methods is required. Experience with statistical software packages such as STATA is preferred. Prior experience in the context of a research project is desirable. Excellent written and oral command of English is required. Basic knowledge of an additional language, either French, Italian or Spanish, is an asset.

Interest in interdisciplinary collaborations with other **nccr – on the move** collaborators in the framework of different NCCR events is desirable. Participation in an interdisciplinary doctoral program coordinated by the University of Neuchâtel is expected. Regular attendance of events at the University of Neuchâtel, or elsewhere in Switzerland, is required.

Benefits: The salary and working conditions (activity percentage etc.) are in accordance with the regulations of the Swiss National Science Foundation. The **nccr – on the move** offers attractive working conditions, including support measures for researchers with childcare duties.

Employer: The position is based at the Graduate Institute, Geneva. The Graduate Institute (IHEID) is an Equal Opportunities Employer. Qualified women and candidates with a migration history are encouraged to apply.
